LAMDA Graded Examinations in **Speaking in Public** are designed to develop the skills necessary for effective oral communication and public presentation. This qualification will benefit those wishing to communicate confidently using English language. The qualification is designed to enable learners to develop a range of skills in public speaking. Learners will be able to explore and select appropriate subject matter and prepare and deliver two speeches. Effective preparation and study will be evident, leading to a confident performance. Learners will be able to answer questions on the skills required for preparing their speeches and maintain a conversation with the Examiner on a given topic.

## LAMDA: Level 2 Award in Communication: Speaking in Public

#### Overview

**Grade 4:** The learner will deliver two speeches. Speech 1 will be on a subject of their own choice. Speech two will be based on a selected topic set by LAMDA.
